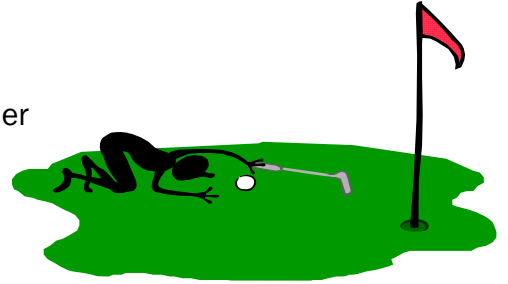
Course Conditions

Due to the high temperatures, high humidity, and large amount of rain, we have disease present in some fairways.

Handicap Rules:

- 1) Passengers who do not qualify as handicapped are to walk to their ball from the path when riding with a handicapped member.
- 2) Use the 90 degree rule when driving to and from the path, do not drive the length of the hole in fairway.
- 3) After rains please avoid low areas which may be wet.
- 4) Please walk to the greens and tees from paths if you are physically able.
- 5) At any time, due to drought, disease, high temperatures, and/or wet conditions, the maintenance department can restrict all carts to the path for the well being of the golf course. If this occurs it will be listed on the course information board in the clubhouse.
