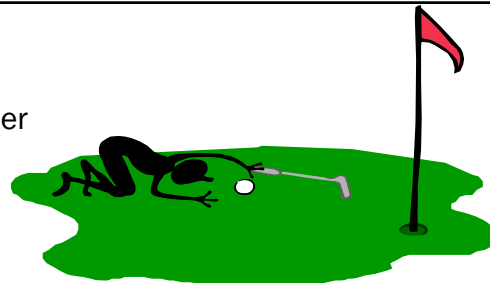

Course Conditions

The original nine fairways and 14 have been sliced and seeded with blue grass, this seed takes up to 21 days just to germinate, so you may encounter sprinklers running during the day for the next month to keep the seed moist. Sorry for the inconvenience.

Handicap Rules:

- 1) Passengers who do not qualify as handicapped are to walk to their ball from the path when riding with a handicapped member.
