Tis the Season for Diseases

You will notice some patches of disease in the fairways, the grass that is affected are the ryegrass and the poa annua. Bluegrass which is the grass we want our fairways to predominately consist of is very tolerant of the disease. Therefore we are not spraying the diseases this summer on fairways, and are applying fertilizer applications more frequently to encourage the bluegrass to fill in the voids.
