### Course Reminders:

- No sunflower seeds
- Dispose of cigarettes and cigars
- Properly repair ballmarks
- Fill divots with sand and seed
- Pick up broken tees
- Observe cart rules
- Cart Path only on 2,6,9-17
- Keep carts out of native areas



The bridges are set and adjustments have been made. The next step is for the retaining walls to be built and backfilled. Then concrete will be used to deck the bridges and pour the paths. Estimated completion will be the end of April. We will not be doing aerification to the greens this spring. We will be needle tining and verti-cutting which will cause minimal interruption to play.
