

# WCC Handicap Flag Holder Policy Agreement

## Yellow (Access) Flags

If a member is 80 years of age or has a certification of disability for disabled parking placard and/or plate, they will be allowed to fly an access flag (YELLOW) vertically and upright where it can be easily identified by course employees, marshals, and other golfers. Flag holders will follow the **90-degree rule** on hole 9,13,14, and 16. They will **NOT** be allowed to leave the path on par 3's or hole #11. Flag holders can take another flag holding member to their ball, but will **NOT** be allowed to take non flag holding members to their ball.

## Red (Disability) Flags

These flags will allow you to drive to your ball on any hole including par 3's and hole #11 if needed. You can also drive closer to the greens to avoid some of the steeper walks to the green (11 green, 14 green). These flags will be appointed by the board only and have no automatic age qualification. Members will have to come to a board meeting and apply in person for a Red Flag.

A onetime \$40.00 fee is required for the purchase of the flag

3<sup>rd</sup> Offense: Member will lose Flag privileges for remainder of year
